### GETTING TO EROICA BRITANNIA AND ARRIVING ON SITE

To download and print a map of the Festival grounds that shows all entrance points for Arrivals click [HERE](#). We recommend you do so and bring this map with you to the event.

**All motorised vehicle arrivals should head to the gates on the A515 as these are the only entry points for to site this year for vehicles.**

**Those arriving by bicycle or on foot can access site via either the gates on the A515 OR via the gate that leads in from the High Peak Trail. Please see the Arrivals Map for where this is.**

**We're running a colour-coding system for each A515 gate so read below and head to the gate relating to your ticket purchase based on colour.**

#### **RED GATE**

Single Day Parking, 3 Day Parking and Tent Camping Arrivals only.

#### **GREEN GATE**

Single Day Parking, 3 Day Parking and Tent Camping Arrivals, plus motorhomes, caravans, trailer tents and Boutique camping parking. The Green gate is also our pick-up and drop off point for passenger vehicles & taxis.

### **TENT CAMPING ARRIVALS - RED or GREEN GATE**

**Tent Camping arrivals can enter via either the Red Gate or the Green Gate on the A515.**

Upon arrival to the Red or Green Gate please have your pre-booked Camping Parking ticket ready for scanning, which will be exchanged for a Parking Pass that needs to be displayed in your vehicle window at all times.

Once you have parked and secured the Parking Pass in the window of your vehicle you will need to head on foot to the Arena Box Office to exchange your Camping Pitch Tent ticket & Festival tickets for corresponding wristbands for you and your party.

The Arena Box Office is only a short walk from the Car Parks and will be clearly signed.

After redeeming your Camping Pitch Tent ticket from the Arena Box Office you are then free to set up camp in the Tent Camping fields. This will mean carrying your camping equipment and belongings with you.

[Rainbow Barrow Hire](#) will be positioned in the Car Parks and hiring out pull-along trolleys should you need them.

If you have a Parking Pass displayed in your vehicle you can drive off and back on to site freely during the event. Please note that parking spaces are not reserved, so if you leave site you are not guaranteed the same parking space on your return.

Please be aware that you cannot drive into the Tent Camping fields under any circumstances due to fire regulations. You will be required to first park your vehicle and carry your belongings and equipment to your camping pitch located in the Tent Camping fields.

## **CARAVAN/MOTORHOME/TRAILER TENT ARRIVALS - GREEN GATE ONLY**

**Motorhomes, Trailer Tents & Caravans must arrive via the GREEN GATE on the A515.**

Upon arrival to the Green Gate please have your pre-booked Camping Pitch Motorhome/Trailer Tent/Caravan ticket ready for scanning, which will be exchanged for a Live-In Vehicle Pass that needs to be displayed in your vehicle window at all times.

Please note that vehicles towing Trailer Tents or Caravans can park next to your camping pitch.

Once you have been directed into position by one of our stewards, and secured your Live-In Vehicle Pass in the window of your vehicle, you will need to head on foot to the Arena Box Office to exchange your Festival tickets for corresponding wristbands for you and your party.

The Arena Office is only a short walk from the Live-In Vehicle Camping Fields and will be clearly signed.

After redeeming your Camping Pitch Motorhome/Trailer Tent/Caravan ticket from the Arena Box Office you are then free to set up camp in the Motorhome/Trailer Tent/Caravan Camping fields.

### **3 DAY PARKING (NOT CAMPING) & ONE DAY PARKING - RED or GREEN GATE**

**3 Day Parking & One Day Parking arrivals can enter via either the Red Gate or the Green Gate on the A515.**

If you have purchased a 3 Day Parking ticket or a One Day Parking ticket for the Friday, Saturday or Sunday please head to either the Red or Green Gate depending if you are heading from the North, South or East. Both gates are accessed off the A515. These gates will be clearly signed.

For directions to the Red or Green Gate click [HERE](#). Or simply enter our postcode, SK17 0DY in to your Sat Nav and follow our signs on arrival to site.

Upon arrival to the Red or Green Gate please have your pre-booked Parking ticket ready for scanning, which will be exchanged for a Parking Pass that needs to be displayed in your vehicle window at all times.

Once you have parked and secured the Parking Pass in the window of your vehicle you will need to head on foot to the Arena Box Office to exchange your Festival tickets for corresponding wristbands for you and your party. You can then enter the Festival through the Arena Box Office entrance.

## ON-THE-DAY PARKING – RED or GREEN GATE

**On-the-day parking can enter via either the Red Gate or the Green Gate on the A515.**

If you are joining us as a day visitor, haven't pre-purchased a parking ticket and wish to pay for parking on the day, please head to either the Red or Green Gate depending if you are heading from the North, South or East. Both gates are accessed off the A515. These gates will be clearly signed.

For directions to the Red or Green Gate click [HERE](#). Or simply enter our postcode, SK17 0DY in to your Sat Nav and follow our signs on arrival to site.

Upon arrival to the Red or Green Gate please state to the stewards you wish to pay for on-the-day parking and we will exchange cash for a corresponding Parking Pass. On-the-day parking will be charged at £10 per vehicle per day.

Once you have parked and secured the Parking Pass in the window of your vehicle you will need to head on foot to the Arena Box Office to exchange your Festival tickets for corresponding wristbands for you and your party. You can then enter the Festival through the Arena Box Office entrance.

## BOUTIQUE CAMPING & PARKING – GREEN GATE ONLY

If you have booked Boutique Camping and/or Boutique Camping Parking please head to Green Gate which is located on the A515.

For directions to the Green Gate click [HERE](#). Or simply enter our postcode, SK17 0DY in to your Sat Nav and follow our signs on arrival to site.

Upon arrival to the Green Gate you will be directed to the Boutique Car Park. Please have your Boutique Parking ticket ready for scanning, which will be exchanged for a Parking Pass that needs to be displayed in your vehicle window at all times.

Once you have parked and secured the Parking Pass in the window of your vehicle you will need to head on foot to the Boutique Camping Box Office to exchange all tickets for corresponding wristbands for you and your party. You can then enter the Festival through the Arena Box Office entrance.

### **PICK-UP & DROP-OFF & TAXIS - GREEN GATE ONLY**

For all drop-offs and pick-ups please head to the Green Gate which is located on the A515.

For directions to the Green Gate click [HERE](#). Or simply enter our postcode, SK17 0DY in to your Sat Nav and follow our signs on arrival to site.

Upon arrival to the Green Gate your driver will be instructed on where to pull in and drop-off. From there you can make your way to the Arena Box Office to exchange your Festival tickets for corresponding wristbands for you and your party. You can then enter the Festival through the Arena Box Office entrance. On departure please head to the Green Gate to be picked-up by your vehicle.

### **ALL RIDER & FESTIVAL VISITOR ARRIVALS**

Once you have arrived to site via your own vehicle, your bicycle, public transport or on foot please head to the Arena Box Office to exchange your Ride or Festival tickets for corresponding wristbands for you and your party. You can then enter the festival through the Arena Box Office entrance.

All Classic Riders must retain a copy of their Classic Ride entry ticket as this will include your allocated Rider Number. You'll then be directed to the Eroica HQ marquee located in the Main Festival Arena, and once there go to Rider Registration to redeem your Rider Pack containing all vital items (jersey & bike number, route card, etc), together with your Rider goodie bag. It's important you show your Classic Ride Entry ticket at Rider Registration in order to be issued the correspondingly numbered envelope and goodie bag.
